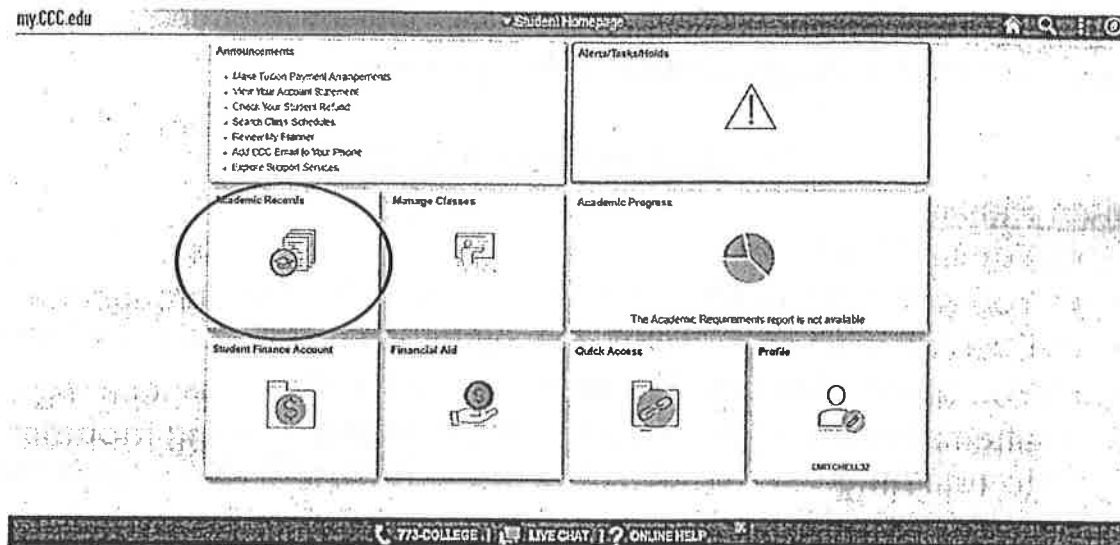


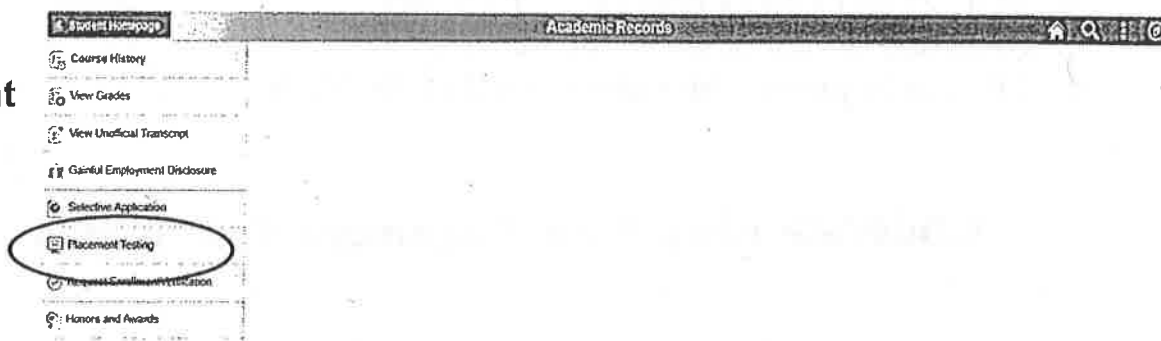
# How To Take Your Math Placement Test From Home

1. Log into your student portal: [my.ccc.edu](http://my.ccc.edu)

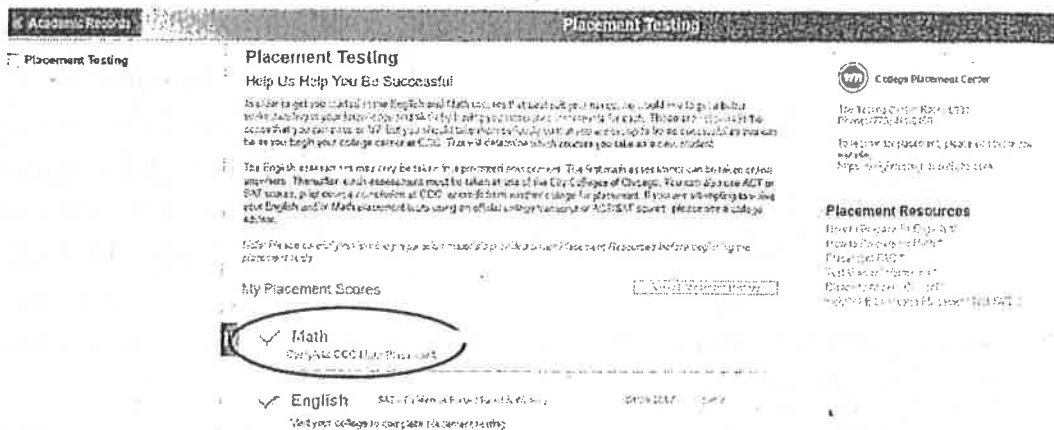
2. Click on **Academic Records**



3. Click on **Placement Testing**

## Math Placement Test

- You may take the math placement test up to 5 times.
- You will be able to take your first attempt at home through the student portal.
- Every attempt after your first **must** be proctored.
- You will be required to complete 3 hours of prep and learning between each attempt. **You must complete the prep and learning modules from home prior to retesting.**
- A waiver can be placed if you have the following score on either your individual ACT/SAT or AP Math exams:
  - ACT: 21 or higher within the last 4 years
  - SAT: 530 or higher within the last 4 years
  - AP: 3 or higher on AP college level math exam

## Understanding Your Placement Test Scores

### MATH

ALEKS Score range	Course Placement
Less than 19%	Foundational Studies 3001 + 3002
20-29%	Foundational Studies 3003 + 3004 Math 098/Math 090
30-45%	Math 118+ co-requisite, Math 125+ co-requisite, Math 99
46-60%	Math 118, 121, 125, 140, 141, 143
61-100%	Math 144, 146, 204
76-100%	Math 207

**\*Foundational Studies** – This class is designed for students needs a review of basic math in order to take college level math courses.

**Math with co-requisite** – Students can earn 4 college credit hours for Math 118 and Math 125. 2-credit hour co-requisite credit is not counted toward college level credit.

**College Level** – Students who score 46% or higher qualify for college level Math.
